Dear Councillor [REDACTED],

I write to you and others to make you aware of my petition to The UK parliament and ask for your support.

Like many others I am an unpaid carer, additionally and separately I have a vulnerable relative in care, and have, over an extended time frequently reported incidents of neglect and ill-treatment of my relative, providing evidence of such which has been dismissed and concealed by the provider, with assistance from an advocacy service and particular local authority staff.

Further, some MP's have themselves, in parliament, raised and detailed their own unfortunate experiences of their loved ones being abused in care, yet nothing has been done to drive real change.

As such, I have started a petition to The UK parliament for politicians to debate and address making it mandatory for providers to have CCTV in all care, nursing and residential homes where vulnerable people live, and by choice in the homes of vulnerable people and their families.
