Dear Mr Watts,

Regarding your distressing email of 14th April 2020 at 15.13 pm.

I reject your feigned condolences; you are a person I regard as morally corrupt, deceitful, nescient and odious, a person who has been complicit and instrumental in concealing abuse and recurring neglect of my brother.

Further, while you have ignored and failed to respond to my emails for no less than two years, I duly note your absolute failure to understand my brother and disabilities.

Your disregard of providing PPE to my brother, communicating and clarifying such in writing, and your admittance of inability to explain or promote restrictions regarding COVID-19 and distancing to my brother remain grave concerns.

I am far more knowledgeable about my sibling's, communications and understanding than you or any of your colleagues or social care staff are or ever will be, and find your comment disdainful.

You and your colleagues have managed, in a short time, to decimate all that my parents and I established, over 35 years to support and help my brother develop.

Further, had you taken note of the COVID-19 restrictions regarding autistic individual, you would know that restrictions were relaxed before 14th April 2020. Additionally, family members, whether they lived together or not, were allowed to travel and attend funerals, which is in fact in legislation and has not altered since enactment, contrary to your claim.

Regarding your judgment of 'best interest'. I am an interested party in the health and welfare of my brother. I am also to be included in best interest discussions and decisions; you and relevant parties disregarded such.

Had you or your staff not ignored my emails and many attempts to call via the established Skype contacts, as I can evidence, you would have known I requested for your colleagues also to contact other family members declared to remain in contact with my brother.


To only send a single email a mere 32 minutes before our mother's funeral service illustrates your sheer unprofessionalism and utter lack of respect for my family and I.

Regarding phone messages, you nor your colleagues made any attempt to contact me before the funeral service; social care staff only leaving a vague few seconds phone message asking me to return a call, picked up on my return home.

Witnessing what I have, and knowing what I know regarding your involvement in the disregard of neglect and abuse of the vulnerable, including my brother, I recognise you as a disgrace to the care system, the vulnerable and their devoted and caring family members.

You may be able to deceive and mislead others, but not me.
