I write in reply to your letter dated 25th January 2018, received on 27th January 2018, in which you invite me to meet with you and your colleague Ms J [REDACTED] S [REDACTED], on 6th January 2018 at your Plough Lane offices.

Unfortunately, your invitation is not possible. However, and in consideration of your attempt to suppress our website and the threats made by your colleagues, including Ms S [REDACTED] in March 2017, I would be keen to meet, as previously stated in communications, along with a solicitor at a mutually convenient day and time at the solicitor's office.

Regarding your statement that my brother's health and wellbeing is maintained, such should not be so, and amelioration should have occurred long ago, as is his legal rights.

Further, I duly note the refusal by your colleague Ms S [REDACTED], to allow me and my brother to meet at a chosen location on [REDACTED]st February 2018, interferes with our statutory rights, and by doing so denied us of a valued family home visit. Such decision, as you will know, also conflicts not least with the fifth principle of The Mental Capacity Act 2005
