It has been over seven months, as of writing this, since your colleagues at Herefordshire Council confiscated and refused to allow my vulnerable brother to have the desktop PC I build some years ago for his personal use and enjoyment returned to him; assisting in regressing him and his computer skills.

Therefore, for redress, I now require and insist my property is promptly returned to me at the family home along with all peripherals and accessories, including those kept at H[REDACTED] H[REDACTED] since 2013; these include the LED monitor, LED RGB Keyboard, mouse, speakers and bass box, Logitech webcam and white Gigabyte motherboard box containing recovery discs, manuals and parts. The Epson printer can remain with my brother, at Hamilton House.

As you know, I am aware you publically claim to specialise in The Human Rights Act, and other laws, yet have no legal qualification; you should, however, be mindful of not least Schedule 1 Part II Article 1 of said act.

I suggest you handle this matter promptly, given consideration to the time Herefordshire Council have kept the PC, and all property is securely returned to me at the family home by the end of March 2019.

Regarding other matters, I will address these separately, and at a later date.
