Background Information "2. Would moving closer to his family make any difference considering the fact that the obstruction to Mr B [REDACTED] visiting his mother has been communication with Chris, not distance."

This is untrue, both The Priory Group and Herefordshire Council blocked, restricted communication and ignored requests for and on behalf of my brother to come home; this can be seen in many email requests and some phone contact recordings.

Page 6

State "5. Considering the presence of CCTV in the family home and recent safeguarding in relation to filming, it is in the best interest of Mr B [REDACTED] to be recorded during family visits."

As mentioned, the CCTV has been in place since 2011 and only an issue when I reported a carer and social worker for distressing my mother.

It also states **"6. Could the differences between Chris and H [REDACTED] H [REDACTED] be addressed so Mr B [REDACTED] is allowed to remain at his current home where he has now resided for 6 years."**

D [REDACTED] has resided at H [REDACTED] H [REDACTED] since [REDACTED]th December 2013, 4 years not 6 years.
