Dear Councillor [REDACTED],

It has now been over three months since last I wrote to you. Sending a copy of the latest vexatious and threatening letter (attached) from Herefordshire Council's Ms Appleby (Assistant Director for Adults & Wellbeing) & Ms Coughtrie (LA Solicitor), the letter accusing me of defamation, proposing legal action, once again, and demanding I stop writing to councillors.

I remain without notice of said proposed legal action.

Further, and concerningly, you will note within the letter received, dated 1st October 2021, Herefordshire Council declared they have 'no issue of concern' regarding the phone conversation between Ms Coughtrie and me, of which Ms Coughtrie later declared she, conveniently, made no record. Such regarding a previous threat of legal action after exposing recurring neglect of my vulnerable relative.

Therefore, I ask that councillors intervene and pursue the proposed legal action against me, insisting on ceasing the years of deceit & psychological abuse by your council colleagues and allowing notice to be served without further delay so that a court of law can hear and decide upon or pass judgement.

As a side note, I was kindly granted permission by a Court of Protection judge to seek redress regarding your council employed colleagues.

Lastly, I also request that my local councillor contact me to assist in my appeal against incorrectly charged council tax.

Payments I was forced to produce due to the detrimental effect the punitive restrictions imposed by Alistair Neill and Stephen Vickers had, resulting in my claim for reduction and personal information being mishandled and deleted by Herefordshire Council.

I look forward to hearing from my councillor, welcoming an early reply, and to receiving notice.
