Thank you for your email, and my apology for the slow response.
There will be a bit of a delay.

At present, I am endeavouring to keep stress levels as reduced as I possibly can due to impending brain surgery. The result of the years of psychological abuse by Herefordshire Council and the harm it has caused.

The operation and recovery going well, and once I am home in a couple of weeks, I will check the records I have further and upload anything relevant.

However, there has been communication between me and the latest interim solicitor for the LA, Mr Francis Fernandes, regarding their proposed legal action against me. It has taken no less than twelve attempts of requesting that the LA uphold their vexatious threat and face me in a court of law. As previously mentioned, they eventually sendt me a deceptive letter retracting said proposed legal action. Please let me know if you want copies.

I've not looked at records further, aside from communications from the current LA solicitor for Herefordshire Council regarding proposed legal action against me, which after my accepting their vexatious proposal multiple times, they have declined to progress.

However, I note although their main network has been blocked for a considerable time, LA staff have continued to search for data and access the website from remote addresses, as recently as 10th November 2022 from Bing.com, presumably still without legal authorisation and continuing to collect my data from other sources.

Thank you for your email dated 22nd December 2022 (copy below).

I believe what you have dated 23rd May 2022 is the last correspondence from Herefordshire Council regarding my SAR; I was considering asking for further data but would request your advice.

However, I have uploaded the later letter correspondence from Herefordshire Council regarding their proposed legal action, within these letters I mention I am aware of their extensive unauthorised, therefore unlawful due to RIPA legislation, monitoring, data collection & sharing regarding my internet presence and social media.

Further, I note the LA continue to monitor my website as recently as 29th of November 2022 from a remote access address, so it is highly likely they continue to do the same without legal authority regarding my web presence and social media. What do you suggest I do?

As a side note, while no assumption should be drawn, I am aware of Mr Fernandes's past interview under caution by the police.
