Thank you for your email of 19 February 2023. Your complaint has been investigated to the extent appropriate and my previous correspondence has indicated to you the next steps you may take.

If you are concerned that Herefordshire Council is conducting surveillance of you, you may be able to submit a complaint to the Investigatory Powers Tribunal. The Tribunal can consider complaints from individuals who believe they have been subject to unlawful covert surveillance by a public authority.
