I duly note, although viewed the past five family home visits for my brother have been denied due to the wilful ignorance of my request emails for such; denying him and us of our right to private and family life.

I suggest that you liaise between H [REDACTED] house and me to arrange a family home visit on 22nd March 2017.

I request confirmation of the above via email from your organisation within 24 hours of receiving.

The document named "H [REDACTED] House family home visit restrictions.pdf," previously sent, remains in effect and until further notice.

I suggest that you do not persist in neglecting, denying or restricting my brother's right to visit his family and that abuse of the DoLS order does not continue. Further, he should not be treated less favourably than other residents where arrangements for transport are required.
