Further, I am deeply concerned by your letter, which contains inaccurate and misleading statements.

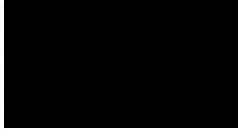
Contrary to your assertions, I hold substantial evidence of Herefordshire Council's activity regarding searching, monitoring and data collection of my web presence, social media and websites over an extended period, in conflict with your written declaration.

Additionally. You state that the Council views publicly available information on social media sites and news articles. However, such is neither a reasonable nor adequate response to my request regarding specific searches and legitimate reasons for multiple visits and data collection while circumventing network restrictions to monitor my web presence, social media and websites, Notably in consideration of previous and numerous vexatious proposals and threats of legal action received from Herefordshire Council and the already known exchanges of communications between your colleagues.

Therefore, I demand that you provide what I requested in my letter to Mr Paul Walker dated 6th March 2023 and that you cease your attempted misdirection.

I expect to hear from you within ten days regarding progress of this matter.
