**Subject Access Request & Unreasonable Behaviour Policy**

The Council has responded to your Subject Access Request in full on 23 May 2022.

The Information Commissioners Office has dismissed your complaint and upheld the Council's position in relation to your Subject Access Request on 16 January 2023.

I have subsequently written to you to repeat the same and advised that the Council cannot assist you further.

Despite all of this, you have now commenced to email Councillors on the same matter. Between 07 June and 26<sup>th</sup> June 2023, 143 emails have been received by Councillors from you. You are repeating the same points that have already been resolved by the Council and as supported by the ICO.

Please refrain from continuing to contact the Council, Officers or Councillors on this matter.

If you continue to contact the Council, Officers or Councillors about the same matters without raising new issues, or continue to refuse to accept our responses, the Council will take appropriate action against you under the unreasonable behaviour policy, a copy of which is enclosed.

Persistent contact on issues already answered has a significant impact on Council time and resources and the ability for them to deal with other customers who may need assistance.
