Dear Mr Walker,

Further to my letter of the 6th of March 2023 to you. And the most recent follow-up response of the 20th of July 2023 from your Head of Legal, Mr Sean O'Connor, who has been obstructive and lacked such cooperation that I liken the experience to dealing with a poorly trained Basset Hound.

It's unmistakable that the council refuses to admit to any further dates of the extended monitoring/surveillance of my web presence and social media without lawful authorisation and any other records of such activity.

A period during which Herefordshire Council, while not an extensive list:

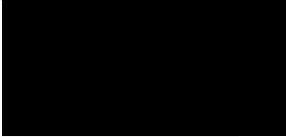
- * Concealed neglect of my brother and incidents.
- * Refused us of significant private family events, such as funerals, including our mother's, in direct conflict with guidance and legislation. And that of a foster brother before the pandemic.
- * Misled the Court of Protection. I believe intentionally deceiving the judge.
- * Lied to the HCPC about the employment of a social worker using the protected title before registration (a criminal offence).
- * Attempted and failed to fabricate criminal offences against me for exposing inadequate care & support of both my brother and our mother.
- * Lied about the existence of a detailed Police report.

However, I remain insistent that the information relating to the precise dates I previously listed in my letter from all council networks and employee-used connections is provided, Including individual, specific, explicit and legitimate reasons for visits, time of visits and duration spent on each access and viewing, and that such evidential record is provided without repeated additional delay.

Additionally, I ask again for Mr Sean O'Connor's statement of truth. As previously requested via councillors.

Lastly, should I receive anything other than the requested via email or post, such as further aggressive, threatening, demanding, erroneous and vexatious communications from Mr O'Connor, I will regard it as harassment and report it to the police and Solicitor Regulatory Authority.
