Dear Mr Bury,

Unreasonable Behaviour

I reference your letter of the 12 March 2024.

On a number of occasions you have been advised that you have been declared vexatious and the Council will not respond to you on this matter. You have been provided with what we held and irrespective of you raising the same question to different parties, the answer remains the same.

Despite this, you persist in writing to us. Your vexatious status has therefore been extended by 6 months. Please refer to my letter of the 05 September 2023 where the sanctions have been explained.

I should make it clear that this in no way restricts your right to approach any other external body in relation to your matters. I feel that we have struck the balance between allowing you to contact officers via a single point of contact when you need to raise a concern and also protecting our staff and resources.

These sanctions will remain in place for 6 months and will be reviewed on 14 September 2024. You will be advised in writing should the period be extended.

If you do not abide by these restrictions/sanctions, or if there are any further incidents of unacceptable behaviour, consideration will be given to taking further action against you.
